# PRESENTATION SUMMARY

# Janet McConnell

## **DESCRIPTION OF PRESENTATION**

Not going back and forth from extreme right and extreme left, a more democratic system is needed.

#### **KEY THEMES**

Janet McConnell told the hearing that she believes that a Proportional Representation (PR) electoral system is the only hope for democracy in British Columbia. She described the current political system as one of 'serial dictatorship.' She made a number of criticisms of the current electoral system, including the lack of diversity of views represented in the legislature, the lack of an official opposition, and extreme policy swings. Mrs McConnell argued that a PR electoral system would result in more stable policies because governments would have to work together cooperatively to achieve consensus. She predicted that voter turnout would increase under PR because they would realize that their vote really counts. Mrs McConnell also supported having separate votes for the party and for the candidate, which would allow voters to vote for the best candidate in their area regardless of their party affiliation, and still have their ideological views represented in the legislature via the party vote.

#### RECOMMENDATIONS

Janet McConnell recommended the introduction of MMP in British Columbia.

Quote: "At the moment we have massive swings to the right and to the left. Each party that wins a majority then sets about undoing the legislation brought in by its predecessor."
