Guy La Flam spoke in favour of proportional representation, and said that he was happy to leave details of which proportional system to introduce in BC to the Citizens' Assembly. He recommended that the Assembly request a change to their mandate in order to hold a referendum on the electoral system before the next election, "otherwise the people of Iraq will have democracy before we do."

RECOMMENDATIONS

Guy La Flam recommended a proportional representation electoral system for BC.

He also recommended that if the Assembly decided in favour of changing the electoral system, that the provincial referendum be held prior to the next provincial election.
